## Registration Procedures for Weekend Camp Events

1. Complete the appropriate registration form. If you register a troop, please collect and bring the signed permission slips. If you register as an individual, please complete the release form included in this packet.
2. Acceptance is on a first-come, first-served basis. Events fill quickly so please turn in forms as soon as possible.
3. A nonrefundable deposit of \$25 per person is due at registration. The full balance is due 60 days prior to the first day of the event. **DO NOT SEND MORE THAN ONE REGISTRATION FORM PER TROOP.**
4. Deposit of payment is **not** a guarantee of placement.
5. Upon acceptance, a confirmation packet including a map to Camp Scherman will be sent to you. Please allow at least 2 weeks to be contacted to find out if your registration was accepted. **Please do not call the Council; we will notify you within 2 weeks.**
6. If accepted, your deposit will be applied to the overall cost of the camp event.
7. If not accepted, your deposit will be refunded.
8. Please use the ratios from the *Safety-Wise* chapter of *Volunteer Essentials* ratios when registering adults with troops or groups for program events:
  - 2 Adults for 5 Girl Scout Daisies plus one adult for each additional 4 girls
  - 2 Adults for 12 Girl Scout Brownies plus one adult for each additional 6 girls
  - 2 Adults for 16 Girl Scout Juniors and Cadettes plus one adult for each additional 8 girls
  - 2 Adults for 20 Girl Scout Cadettes plus one adult for each additional 10 girls
  - 2 Adults for 24 Girl Scout Seniors and Ambassadors plus one adult for each additional 12 girls

This is the minimum number of adults permitted for weekend camps. You must have at least two adults attend with your troop unless otherwise indicated.

## Cancellation and Refund Procedures for Camp Events

1. Once your registration has been confirmed and space has been saved, refunds will only be issued as stated below:
  - a. Full refund (less \$25 per person deposit) if notice is received 60+ days prior to the start of the program.
  - b. 50% refund (less \$25 per person deposit) if notice is received between 30 and 59 days prior to the start of the program.
  - c. No refund if notice is received less than 30 days prior to the start of the program.
2. No refunds will be made if you cancel due to weather conditions. All events are held rain, sleet, sunshine, etc. unless we feel that conditions are unsafe. If the program is canceled, all refunds will be made in full.
3. **After phoning the Council to cancel, all requests for refunds must be made in writing and addressed to GSCOC, Attention: Camp Refund, or [stomas@gscoc.org](mailto:stomas@gscoc.org).**
4. Request must include: Participants Name, Event Name and Event Date.
5. If you are eligible for a full or partial refund, all written requests must be received within **two weeks after the camp event ends, as long as the phone notification was made prior to the camp event.**
6. We reserve the right to cancel an event due to low registration. A full refund will be made if this occurs.

**CAMP SCHERMAN RELEASE, WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT**

I (we), the undersigned parent, parents, or legal guardian of \_\_\_\_\_, a minor, hereby request that she be permitted to attend the Girl Scout Council of Orange County’s Camp Scherman (“Camp”) from \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_, and consent to my child’s participation in all activities associated with attendance at Camp, including off-site activities (collectively “Camp Activities”).

I am aware that while attending Camp, my child may engage in physical activities which may create a risk of harm to my child. I further understand that because of the nature of Camp, my child will not be constantly supervised, therefore potentially giving rise to certain unforeseen circumstances. These risks, in addition to all other possible risks, could result in injury and/or death, and my child and I fully understand the risks and the potential harm that can be associated with participating in Camp and the various Camp Activities. In consideration of my child being permitted to attend Camp and participate in Camp Activities, I hereby:

1. Agree to indemnify and save and hold the Girl Scout Council of Orange County, their directors, officers, employees and agents (collectively “GSCOC”) harmless from any liability, loss, damage, or cost that may occur or be incurred due to the participation of my child in Camp, including all Camp Activities and travel to and from Camp;
2. Release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue GSCOC from all liability to me, my child, her personal representatives, assigns, heirs and next of kin for any loss or damages, and any claim or demands on account of injury to or resulting in death of my child, whether caused by the negligence of GSCOC or of any other person while my child is at Camp, engaged in Camp Activities, or traveling to or from Camp;
3. Assume full responsibility for and risk of bodily injury or death, whether due to the negligence of the GSCOC or otherwise, while attending Camp, engaged in Camp Activities, or traveling to or from Camp. I expressly acknowledge and understand that accidents and injuries may occur while at Camp and expressly assume all of the risks due to the negligence of GSCOC and any others participating or contributing to Camp;
4. Expressly agree, permit and assume the risk of any medical treatment which may be rendered and agree to expressly release and indemnify GSCOC from any liability for providing, or failing to provide, any emergency medical treatment. Furthermore, notwithstanding any medical condition the nature of which I have disclosed to the GSCOC, I consent to allow my child to attend Camp. Furthermore, I expressly agree to assume the risks of any medical treatment which may be rendered, or failed to be rendered, with respect to such medical condition, by the GSCOC and any other party contributing to operation of Camp.

I further expressly agree that the foregoing release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of California and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

I have read, fully understood its content and voluntarily sign this release, waiver, and indemnity agreement. I further agree that no oral representations, statements, or inducement apart from the foregoing written agreement have been made.
